Directions: From Joshua Tree take La Contenta Road south from Highway 62, cross Yucca Trail and continue on dirt road following the sign to Covington Flats area. Park in the pull out just before Park boundary.

A Walk Down Nolina Peak

The Mojave Desert Land Trust invites you to become familiar with the 639 acres of Nolina Peak, a wildland property adjacent to Covington Flats in Joshua Tree National Park. To identify the peak look for the cell tower on the long ridge south of Highway 62 in Yucca Valley.

You will enjoy the breathtaking views and learn about the natural history and geology of this exquisite wild landscape. There are deer, pinyon jays and mountain quail in this desert woodland. This is an easy 1.5-mile walk down the gently graded cell tower road. Transportation to the top will leave plenty of time and energy for the stroll downhill. There is no charge for the walk; however, you will have an opportunity to make a contribution toward the purchase of this property, which will be given to Joshua Tree National Park, forever preserving your view.
